WHAT ARE WE DOING?

- *Screening staff for fever, symptoms or exposure each day before their shift begins*
- *Cleaning frequently & carefully*
- *Wearing protective equipment*
- *Spacing office visits 30 minutes apart to ensure proper distancing*
- *Moving ill patients away from the lobby*
- *Testing established ORHC patients for Covid-19 after patient is seen by the medical provider*
- *Offering telephone services for high risk patients to decrease any potential exposure*



WHAT CAN YOU DO?

- *Wash your hands often – lather for at least 20 seconds before rinsing*
- *Stay home as much as possible, especially if you are ill or high risk*
- *Attempt to distance yourself from others by 6 feet*
- *Wear a mask when in public, especially if high risk*
